2010 – 2011 First Year (1L) Student Cost of Attendance

The College of Law provides students with a budget of anticipated costs for the J.D. degree program at Syracuse University College of Law. Figures 1 through 4 (below) represent the cost of tuition and fees for a first year law student (1L) engaged in full-time study for the 2010-2011 academic year.

Expenses within the budget categories 5 through 11 (below) have been estimated and will vary from student to student. These variations are acceptable as long as they do not exceed the maximum of \$63,700. For figures 5 through 11 take into account all of your anticipated educational expenses for one academic year of study, which covers the nine month period from late August 2010 through May 2011.

Additional expenses must be approved by the College of Law Financial Aid Office with the proper documentation. Allowable types of budget adjustments may include the one-time cost of purchasing a computer or child care expenses, for example.

Expenses NOT allowed in the educational budget include costs of moving, payment of consumer debt (such as credit card payments), the purchase or upkeep of an automobile, costs associated with finding employment (interview expenses, clothing), and expenses incurred during periods of non-enrollment (i.e. summer).
