2018– 2019 Cost of Attendance – LL.M. Program

The College of Law requires LL.M. students complete a minimum of 24 Law credits to obtain the degree. Students must enroll in a minimum of 9 credits per semester and may complete the LL.M. degree over 2 or 3 semesters. The total cost-of-attendance depends on the length of a student’s course of study. Use the tables below to determine your estimated total cost-of-attendance.

Additional expenses must be approved by the College of Law Financial Aid Office with the proper documentation. Allowable types of budget adjustments may include the one-time cost of purchasing a computer or childcare expenses, and the cost to purchase health insurance.

All full-time students are required to have Affordable Care Act (ACA) compliant insurance coverage during the academic year. If you do not have sufficient coverage and need to purchase the university-sponsored insurance plan, the cost of the policy may be included in your cost of attendance upon request. An estimated fee of \$2,250 for Health Insurance will be charged to all full-time students. This mandatory fee may be waived if a student has adequate private health insurance coverage. Expenses NOT allowed in the educational budget include costs of moving, payment of consumer debt (such as credit card payments), the purchase or upkeep of an automobile, costs associated with finding employment (interview expenses, clothing), and expenses incurred during periods of non-enrollment (i.e. summer). Students bringing dependents should anticipate an additional cost of \$5,000 per semester for each dependent. ***Figures 1 and 2** (above) represent estimated fees for an LL.M. student engaged in full-time study for each semester of study. **Figure 3** is charged once during the academic year. **Figures 4 through 8** (above) may vary from student to student. Please take into account all of your actual and expected expenses for one 4.5-month semester of study. Variations in personal expenses are acceptable as long as they do not exceed the estimated maximum of \$71,650 for 2 semesters of study or \$86,754 for 3 semesters of study.
