Admissions Timeline

June - September

- Begin working on admissions application via [LSAC.org](https://lsac.org)
- Register for the Law School Admission Test (LSAT) and the LSAC [Credential Assembly Service](https://lsac.org/credential-assembly-service) (CAS)
- [Schedule a visit](#)
- Select recommenders to write letters of recommendation and finalize your personal statement

October - December

- Submit admissions application (Please note that Admissions does not begin reviewing applications until November)
- Check your email for receipt of application, [Applicant Status Online](#) (ASO) login and password, missing information and application completion notifications
- Confirm that chosen recommenders have written and submitted your letters of recommendation
- Attend our [Open House](#) on Friday, October 5th

January - February

- Activate your [SU NetID](#)
- Complete any incomplete items on your ASO
- Admissions begins notifying students of decisions (Most decisions are made within 6-8 weeks of file completion)
- Attend our [Open House](#) on Saturday, January 19th

March - May

- If admitted, attend an Admitted Student Day and join the Admitted Student Facebook page
- Submit seat deposit by deadline listed on your admission letter
- Activate your [University email address](#)

May - August

- Review [admitted student website](#) and ASO to ensure you've completed all tasks required for matriculation
- Consult the College of Law [orientation](#) website and prepare to enroll in August
