



2021- 2022 *Estimated* Cost of Attendance - LL.M. Program

The College of Law requires LL.M. students to complete a **minimum of 24 Law credits** in order to obtain the degree. Students must enroll in a minimum of 9 credits per semester. The total cost-of-attendance depends on the length of a student’s course of study.

All full-time students are required to have Affordable Care Act (ACA) compliant insurance coverage during the academic year. An estimated fee for Health Insurance will be charged to all full-time students. This mandatory fee may be waived if a student has adequate private health insurance coverage. For students seeking to borrow U.S. government-funded financial aid, allowable types of budget adjustments may include the one-time cost of purchasing a computer or childcare expenses, and the cost to purchase health insurance. Additional expenses must be approved by the College of Law Financial Aid Office with the proper documentation.

Expenses NOT allowed in the educational budget include costs of moving, payment of consumer debt, the purchase or upkeep of an automobile, costs associated with finding employment, and expenses incurred during periods of non-enrollment. Students bringing dependents should anticipate an additional cost of \$9,500 per semester for each dependent.

Figures 1-4 represent estimated tuition and fees in full-time study. Figure 5 represents a required, but waiveable, charge for student health insurance. Figures 6 through 10 may vary from student to student.

All costs above are expected to be confirmed each Spring semester per University policy and may differ slightly from above.

Note the increase in cost for the 3-semester accounts for increased living expenses and a slight increase in cost per credits. Students may also take more than 24 credits over their 3-semesters and will be charged accordingly. The scenario presented above (i.e. 9, 9, 6 credits per semester) is one "standard" scenario among other options.

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
