



## 2020- 2021 \*Estimated\* Cost of Attendance - SJD Program

The College of Law requires SJD students to spend the first academic year (fall and spring semesters) “in residence” at the College in Syracuse, New York.

Students may spend years 2 through 5 “in research” in Syracuse or away. The tables below show anticipated costs of attendance for students who choose to spend subsequent years in Syracuse or away. Tuition, fees, and personal expenses are subject to change slightly from year to year and the figures provided are estimates.

All full-time students are **required** to have Affordable Care Act (ACA) compliant insurance coverage during the academic year. An estimated fee for Health Insurance will be charged to all full-time students. This mandatory fee **may be waived** if a student has adequate private health insurance coverage. For students seeking to borrow U.S. government-funded financial aid, allowable types of budget adjustments may include the one-time cost of purchasing a computer or childcare expenses, and the cost to purchase health insurance. Additional expenses must be approved by the College of Law Financial Aid Office with the proper documentation.

Expenses NOT allowed in the educational budget include costs of moving, payment of consumer debt, the purchase or upkeep of an automobile, costs associated with finding employment, and expenses incurred during periods of non-enrollment. Students bringing dependents should anticipate an additional cost of \$9,500 per semester for each dependent.

**Figures 1-4** represent estimated tuition and fees in full-time study. **Figure 5** represents a required, but waiveable, charge for student health insurance. **Figures 6 through 10** may vary from student to student.
