

Update from College of Law Career Services: Fall 2020 OCI and Resume Collect  
Program Postponed (Sent April 7, 2020)

Dear Employer Partners,

I hope this note finds you healthy and safe. I write with important news concerning our Fall 2020 OCI and Resume Collect Program.

Over the course of the last month, my team and I have had conversations with many of you regarding the impact of COVID-19 on recruitment plans and hiring needs and projections. Thank you for taking the time to share your impressions and thoughts with me. I have also consulted with my peers at other law schools concerning recruiting plans for the remainder of 2020.

Based on these discussions, today, we are announcing that our Fall 2020 On-Campus Interview (OCI) and Resume Collect Program is postponed until January 2021. Our January event will combine what would have been the efforts and effects of a Fall 2020 and Spring 2021 OCI program, with a likely start date of January 25, 2021. The Program will offer Summer 2021 recruitment opportunities for students who have, at a minimum, completed the full 1L curriculum by May 2021, and post-graduate opportunities for students who will complete their degree by May 2021.

We will continue to consult with you to inform the exact timing and details of the January program. In the meantime, I welcome your comments, reflections, suggestions and updates as you continue to monitor and adjust your hiring needs and projections.

Of course, if you have immediate hiring needs, please let me know. My team and I will be happy to help respond to your call for talent! As we have advised our students, our office is fully operational, and there are many ways for them to continue to advance their career exploration.
