I write with good news that the Trump administration [has rescinded the ICE regulations around online learning for international students](#).

This decision enables international students in the US who are here a student visa to pursue a semester of coursework fully online and you therefore no longer need to comply with the advice below to enroll in at least one 3-credit live/in-person course for the Fall 2020 semester.

We welcome this news, very much, and we thank you for your diligence as we try to respond in real-time to these new and unpredictable challenges.

All students are reminded that you may continue to make changes to your Fall 2020 schedules now, via MySlice, during the course add/drop period that will close next Friday, July 24.
