Dear Students,

This message is intended for all students who plan to be in Dineen Hall or on campus from time to time this fall. If you do not plan to be in Dineen Hall or anywhere on campus this fall, please make sure you have advised [our Registrar's Office](#) and turn to our [law preparedness page](#) concerning the waiver of the health and wellness fee.

If you plan to be in Dineen Hall or on campus from time to time this fall, you must follow these two steps as they relate to testing and quarantining:

1. **Take the COVID-19 Test and submit your results:** Whether you are coming from a state on New York's ["hot" state list](#) or not, you *must* take a COVID-19 test within 10 days of your first arrival to Dineen Hall or the University campus and submit your results before coming to Dineen Hall or campus. [Please click on this link to confirm how to take the test and submit your results](#). If you have submitted your negative result within the requisite 10-day time frame, you may come to Dineen Hall (subject to the quarantine requirements set forth below if they apply to you).
2. **Determine if Quarantine Requirement applies to you and proceed accordingly:** Students coming to Syracuse from hot states or from outside the US received an individualized version of the message below and are [required to self-quarantine for 14 days](#). Please look for the message you received as it contains a personalized link that is your channel for reporting compliance. If you cannot locate the message, you may affirm your compliance with this [self-affirmation of quarantine form](#) or contact the University at studentexperience@syr.edu and let them know you did not receive the message.

Unless and until SU receives your negative results **and** proof of satisfaction of the quarantining requirement if it applies to you, you may *not* come to Dineen Hall or to campus and your Syracuse University ID will be deactivated; please plan to attend class and otherwise participate in College of Law activities remotely.

If you are *not* coming from a hot state or from outside the US, you need not quarantine. You may come to Dineen Hall and campus when you are ready.

Keeping each other safe, healthy, and well means abiding by all health and safety directives from federal, state, local, and University officials through the Fall 2020 semester. Please review the [Stay Safe Pledge](#) and commit to doing your part to prevent the spread of COVID-19. By choosing to be on campus, you are automatically accountable for upholding the pledge. The College of Law Honor Code applies.

Failure to quarantine may result in the imposition of substantial fines by the State of New York. Failure to comply with University directives may result in a referral to the Office of Student Rights and Responsibilities (OSRR) for violation of the Code of Student Conduct, which governs individual and group behavior on and off campus. Sanctions for violating the pledge may be found on the [OSRR website](#), ranging from warnings to expulsion. Failure to comply could also impact state assessments of your character and fitness for purposes of bar admission eligibility.
