Dear Students,

In order to closely monitor COVID-19 infections, Syracuse University has implemented a post-arrival pooled saliva screening procedure that is required of all students who are on campus (in addition to the pre-arrival negative COVID-19 test and evidence of quarantine compliance (if required)).

**Those of you who have not yet participated in this screening procedure and who otherwise have been cleared for access to Dineen Hall, may be screened in the Levy Atrium in Dineen Hall this Thursday between 8 a.m. and 1 p.m.** Please do not eat anything for 30 minutes prior to being screened.

If you cannot participate in the screening on Thursday, SU will contact you to let you know when and where you may be screened on campus at another time.

**If you have *not* submitted your pre-arrival negative COVID-19 test and evidence of quarantine compliance (if required), you will not be able to enter Dineen Hall or be on campus for the purpose of being screened.**

Please be tested off campus first, submit your negative test and evidence of quarantine compliance (if required) and then plan to participate in post-arrival screening elsewhere on campus when you are notified by the University.

These measures are designed to keep our community safe and healthy, and our campus open and accessible for as long as possible. Thank you all for your cooperation.
