Syracuse University College of Law Semester Exchange Program – Estimated Fees & Expenses

The College of Law provides an estimate of the costs that are reasonable for a visiting foreign semester exchange student to attend Syracuse University College of Law.

The figures below represent estimated fees and costs* for a visiting foreign semester exchange student (not including spouse and/or children) relative to mandatory College of Law and Syracuse University fees as well as estimated costs for **monthly** living expenses.

Expenses NOT allowed in the educational budget include costs of SEVIS/visa fees, travel, health insurance costs, moving expenses, payment of consumer debt (such as credit card payments), the purchase or upkeep of an automobile, costs associated with finding employment (interview expenses, clothing), and expenses incurred during periods of non-enrollment.
